Recipe:

15Ml MTSR Cactus
15Ml Fresh Cucumber Syrup
10 Ml lime juice
2 Slice of cucumber
2-3Basil leaves
Top up with soda

Procedure:

Basil Leaves and cucumber

Glass:

Wine Glass

Pink grapefruit and Litchi Lemonade

Recipe:
